1. Name of individual or organization seeking grant;
2. Contact information: mailing address, email address; telephone number(s);
3. Intended purpose/project description;
4. When funds will be used;
5. Amount sought;
6. Project budget;
7. Where applicable, please describe:
  - (a) project management;
  - (b) sustainability;
  - (c) long-term impact;
  - (d) other charitable funding sought or received; and
  - (e) goals and anticipated measures of success.
